



An Evening to Remember

As the main hall filled and guests took their seats, a sense of anticipation settled over the audience. At approximately 6:00 p.m., the long-awaited musical journey of RoarFest '26 officially began.

Setting the tone for the evening was **Viraaga Orchestra**, widely regarded as the foremost Sri Lankan classical ensemble in the United Kingdom, performing under the **musical direction of Vimarsha Jayasinghe**. The orchestra created a rich and immersive soundscape, blending sitar, flute, violin, dual keyboards, bass guitar, acoustic and rhythm guitars, alongside both Western and Eastern percussion. This carefully balanced ensemble provided a refined musical foundation that elevated every performance throughout the night.



The programme was formally opened by **compere Sajith Wathsala**, whose poised delivery, warmth, and measured energy established an immediate connection with the audience and guided the evening with quiet assurance.



The performers the orchestra, the three superstar vocalists, and even the compere appeared in coordinated colours throughout the evening. Whether carefully planned or a fortunate coincidence, the visual harmony subtly echoed the colours of the Wycombe Lions logo, adding an understated sense of unity to the presentation.



The evening's musical journey began with the first of the night's superstars, **Suneera Sumanga**, who opened his performance with a timeless composition by the revered giant of Sri Lankan classical music, Dr. W. D. Amaradeva. Introducing the song with quiet reverence, Suneera paid tribute to the Maestro and expressed his gratitude to Dr. Amaradeva's son for granting him the honour of performing these cherished works. He then delivered a moving rendition of "Aradhana," song of Maestro setting a deeply reflective tone for the night. Suneera followed with his own much loved hit, "Nela Ganumata," before returning once more to Amaradeva's rich musical legacy with "Sanda Horen" and "Pera Dinayaka" tributes to and originally sung by Dr. Amaradewa. Each performance was met with attentive silence and warm appreciation from the audience.

He concluded this segment with another of his popular songs, "Dinaka Apitath," filling the hall with the unmistakable warmth of his voice. Between songs, Suneera shared personal reflections and stories behind the music, offering the audience rare insight into his life and artistic journey. These moments of storytelling added an intimate dimension to the performance, transforming the concert into a shared and deeply human experience.
